MEDICAL SUPPORT

KEARSNEY'S STATE OF THE ART MEDICAL FACILITY

Kearsney College's outstanding medical facilities allow parents to watch their sons play various sports with a sense of comfort, knowing excellent emergency medical attention is available should they be unfortunate enough to sustain an injury.

Dr Mike Marshall, a past president of the SA Sports Medicine Association (SASMA), current Sharks chief medical officer and a Kearsney Old Boy, said the College's medical facilities provide on-duty personnel with the best available facilities at their disposal for treating injured players.

The doctors who are in attendance during the Kearsney Easter Rugby Festival have experience in managing a wide range of musculo-skeletal injuries, as well as the usual general practice complaints. In addition, these practitioners are up-to-date with the current management of concussion, having completed all the appropriate World Rugby training modules.

The doctor-on-duty is supported by a dedicated and professional team of highly trained registered nurses and paramedics, who provide exceptional medical support and best practices on field side, as well as in the four-bed emergency medical facility. The unit has designated areas for suturing, concussion assessment, resuscitation and injury assessment.

The College's medical golf cart assists with efficient removal of injured players off the field to ensure they receive prompt medical attention in the medical facility which is situated within the main grandstand. Fitted with a stretcher, it can transport injured players from any of the school's fields back to the medical room.

Two automated external defibrillators are available to assist in resuscitating collapsed patients should the need arise. An onsite ambulance with paramedic staff is always stationed at the medical facility during the festival.

Busamed's Hillcrest Private Hospital, within a seven-minute drive of the College, offers specialist emergency services, a radiology unit and orthopaedic and neurosurgical specialists.

Of course, no-one wants to be injured, but as Dr Marshall said, "we are equipped to provide the best level of care to any injured player should the need arise".

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DURBAN HIGH SCHOOL

Founded in 1866, Durban High School is a traditional boys' state school, steeped in history and tradition, and known for producing leaders in all walks of life. DHS began playing rugby in 1910 when Maritzburg College old boy AS Langley became headmaster and banned soccer, forcing all boys to play rugby. DHS has produced some notable rugby legends, including Skonk Nicholson and Springboks Neville Todd (1928), Andrew Aitken (1997), BJ Botha (2006) and Alistair Hargreaves (2009). Several players have represented other countries: Greg Rawlinson (New Zealand), Antonie Claassen (France), Graham Downes (USA), Matt Alexander (USA), Wynston Cameron-Dow (Germany) and Senzo Ngubane (Germany). Provincial players include Skonk Nicholson, Jody Jenneker, John Slade, Luzuko Vulindlu, Garth Williamson, Greg Hamilton, Anton Bresler, former DHS 1st XV coach Scott Mathie and, more recently, Phendulani Buthelezi, Celimpilo Gumede and Sanele Nohamba.

From humble beginnings with just 26 boys in 1910, Durban's Glenwood High School has grown to become one of South Africa's leading traditional boys' schools. It has produced seven Springboks, including 2017 Springbok captain Warren Whiteley and 2023 World Cup winner Jaden Hendrikse. There are currently 14 Glenwood old boys playing first class professional rugby in various major rugby competitions across the globe, which places Glenwood as one of four SA schools in the top 15 for most professional rugby players produced by all schools in the world. The Green Machine has also produced two Blitzbokke, 53 Natal players, 216 KZN players and 15 SA Schools' players.

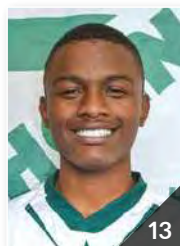

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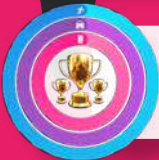


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RONDEBOSCH BOYS' HIGH

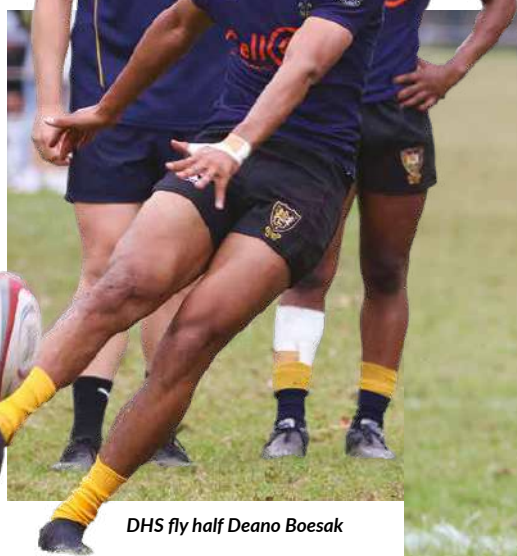

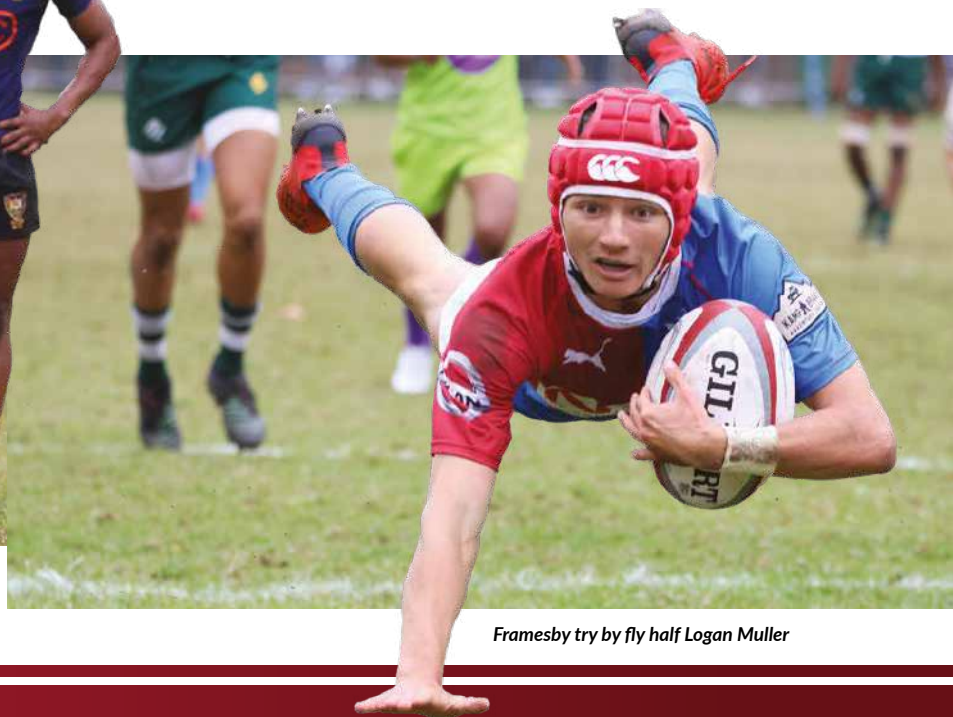

Boarding has many benefits for schoolboys, providing a structured and disciplined environment where the boys benefit academically, whilst enjoying the social and personal development benefits.

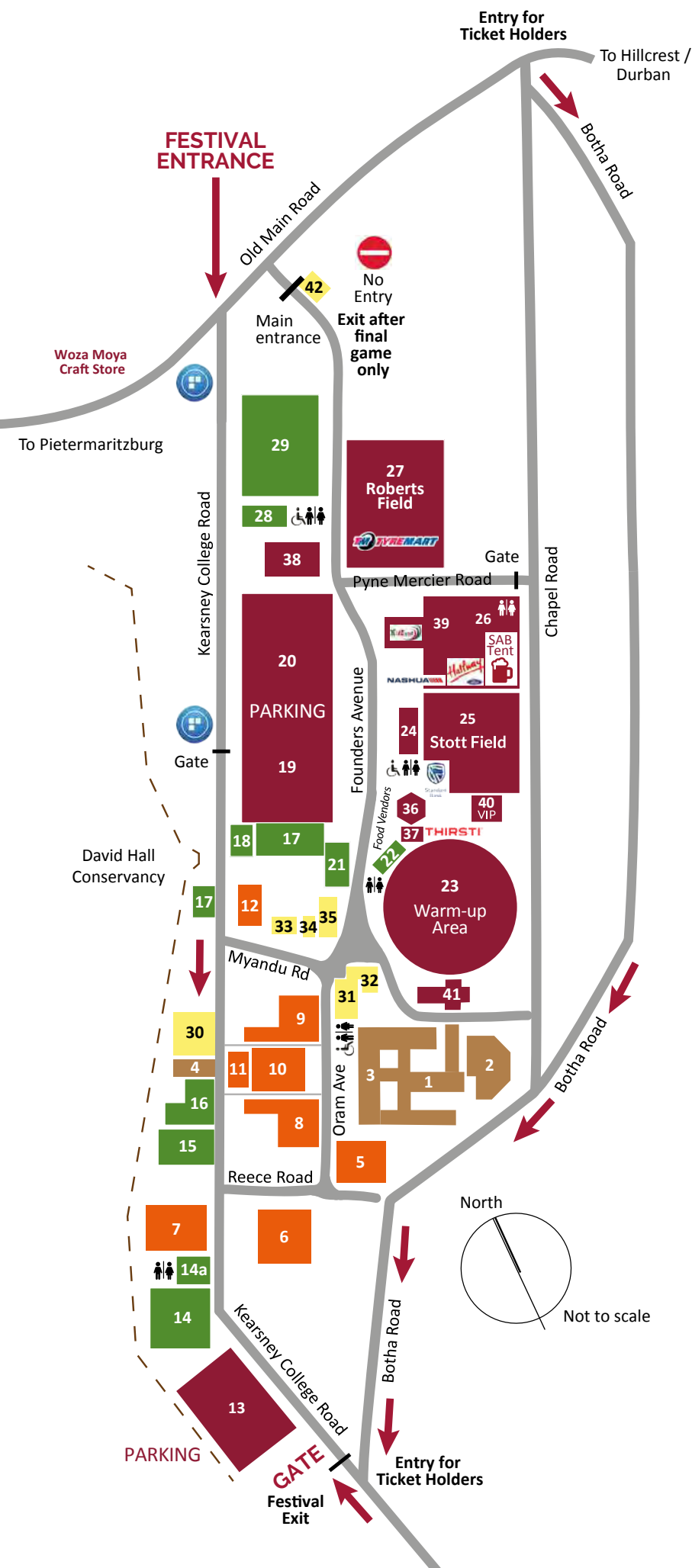
