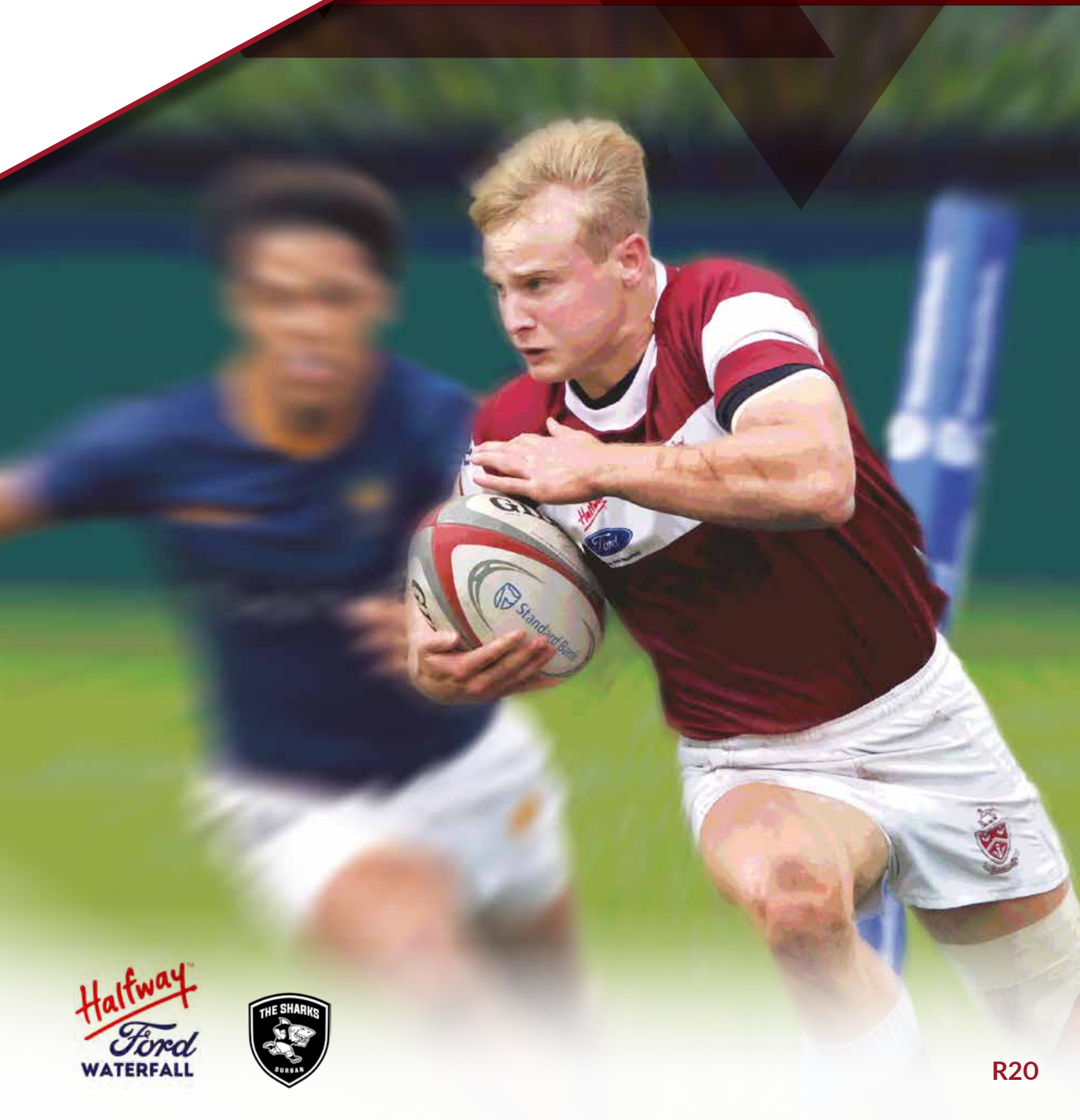

A RUGBY *Dream*

School sports festivals offer so much, to so many people, in so many different ways.

For parents and family, it's the joy and pride of watching a youngster mature from the experience. For supporters of school sport, it's the thrill of watching sports played at this level, often its purest form. For players, it's the fun, the camaraderie, and knowing that sacrifices and passion have been recognised.

And for a few, it can be a life-changing event.

Sports events such as the Kearsney Easter Rugby Festival (KERF) offer a stage from which gifted young players can be noticed, particularly if they live outside regions focused on by talent scouts; providing them with a springboard to the next level of the game.

In 2016 an excitable young speedster joined his teammates on the bus from Qonce (King William's Town) to Botha's Hill, where he arrived practically unknown. During the festival at Kearsney College, Aphelele Fassi's nascent talent was spotted by then-Sharks Academy selector, former Springbok and Kearsney old boy, Etienne Fynn. He ensured that the gifted youngster was nurtured through the channels until he matriculated in 2017 from Dale College in the Eastern Cape, before heading straight to KwaZulu-Natal.

After a successful start to the 2019 Super Rugby season with the Sharks, where he had already been labelled as a 'game breaker', Fassi was on the radar of assistant Springbok coach Jacques Nienaber; and in June 2021 Fassi was told to prepare for the British Lions' tour to South Africa. After a promising first international season, he was elected best young South African player.

Another Eastern Cape youngster who was first noticed at KERF was Lubabalo 'Tera' Mtembu. He played at the inaugural festival in 2008, and returned the following year as captain of Dale College's 1st XV. A gifted loose forward, Tera joined the Sharks straight from school, went on to play SA Sevens, represented South Africa at the Commonwealth Games and eventually played for the New England Free Jacks in Major League Rugby in the United States; before injury forced him into early retirement in 2022, aged 31. Tera is currently part of Kearsney College's 1st XV coaching team.

There's a long list of schoolboys who have thrilled Kearsney Easter Rugby Festival supporters. Handre Pollard was already showing signs of his trademark brilliance at KERF 2011 and 2012, when he thrilled spectators playing at flyhalf for Paarl Gimnasium.

The Hendrikse brothers - Jaden (Glenwood scrumhalf 2017, 2018) and Jordan (Glenwood flyhalf 2019) - were standout players at KERF. Despite the interruption of COVID, both brothers have progressed their rugby trajectory to Springbok level.

Women's rugby is relatively new on the South African sports scene. By offering a platform to four aspiring U16 girls' teams at this year's festival, Kearsney College continues to play an invaluable role at the forefront of development of school sport culture and growth in this country.

Some of the 650 athletes participating at this year's festival will stop playing rugby after school or club level, others will progress to provincial teams but, for a committed group, it could be the realisation of an extraordinary dream which takes them to rugby pitches and tournaments across the globe.

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DALE COLLEGE

Born on the turbulent Eastern Cape frontier town of King William's Town (now Qonce), Dale College has shared more than 160 years of South African history. Its history has mirrored that of our nation - it has seen two civil wars, two world wars, economic ups and downs and decades of racial division. Dale has grown into a great institution which has adapted in a changing South Africa, and is proudly iconic of the community it serves, energised by an exciting vision for the future. A walk through the College corridors reflects the traditions, achievements and glories of the past and present. The school has a proud rugby heritage, having produced 33 Springbok and Sevens players, including Gcobani Bobo, Aphelele Fassi, Aphiwe Dyantyi and Siviwe Soyizwapi. The school is hailed throughout SA as a model of transformation; and has produced a number of significant Old Dalians in every walk of life.

DURBAN HIGH SCHOOL

Founded in 1866, DHS is a traditional boys' state school, steeped in history and tradition, known for producing leaders in all walks of life. DHS began playing rugby in 1910 when Maritzburg College old boy AS Langley became headmaster and banned soccer, forcing all boys to play rugby. DHS has produced some notable rugby legends, including Skonk Nicholson and Springboks Neville Todd (1928), Andrew Aitken (1997), BJ Botha (2006) and Alistair Hargreaves (2009). Several players have represented other countries: Greg Rawlinson (New Zealand), Antonie Claassen (France), Graham Downes (USA), Matt Alexander (USA), Wynston Cameron-Dow (Germany) and Senzo Ngubane (Germany). Provincial players include Skonk Nicholson, Jody Jenneker, John Slade, Luzuko Vulindlu, Garth Williamson, Greg Hamilton, Anton Bresler, Scott Mathie, Phendulani 'Phepsi' Buthelezi, Celimpilo Gumede, Sanele Nohamba and many more. 'Phepsi' became DHS' latest Springbok when he was capped against Portugal last year.

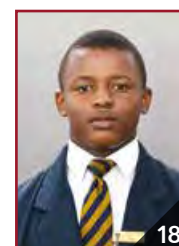

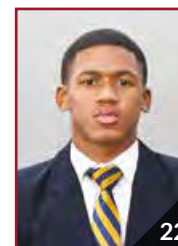

DURBANVILLE

Hoërskool Durbanville, the oldest Afrikaans high school in the country, was founded in 1827 and is already planning its 200th anniversary celebrations for 2027. Today it is a highly respected Afrikaans co-ed boarding school which boasts 1500 learners. As an institution older than 125 years, three years ago Hoërskool Durbanville received heritage status from the Heritage Association of South Africa. Situated in the semi-rural residential suburb of Durbanville on the northern outskirts of Cape Town, the area's inception can be traced to a freshwater spring in the town which was used as a replenishment station for travellers on their way from Cape Town to the interior of SA. The school boasts a number of notable sportsmen: John Trytsman (Springboks), Jayden Nell (SA Blitzbok 7's) and Neil Montgomery (Cayman Islands), as well as various senior Varsity Cup players and two players playing their trade in the Premiership in Italy.

A physical brand of rugby is played at Hoërskool Dr EG Jansen, a school which prides itself on having one of the toughest East Rand sides, regularly taking on the biggest schools in Gauteng. The school has a long and illustrious rugby history, having been the Valke league champions on multiple occasions, as well as winning the coveted Nupower and Beeld trophies in 2013. Based in Boksburg, it can boast having had players like Francois Uys (Free State), Louis Ludick (Sharks), Kevin Buys (Lions) and Ruaan Lerm (Lions and EP Kings), Gunter Smuts (Lions), JP du Preez (Glasgow Warriors) and Erich Cronje (Lions) go through its ranks. The school also has many Craven Week players on a consistent basis, with old boys Pieter Jansen 2013, Hendré Stassen (Stormers) and Nico Peyper (Bulls) being awarded SA Schools colours in 2015.

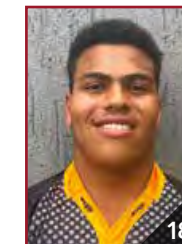

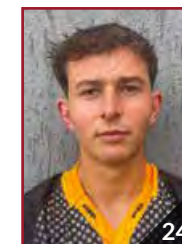

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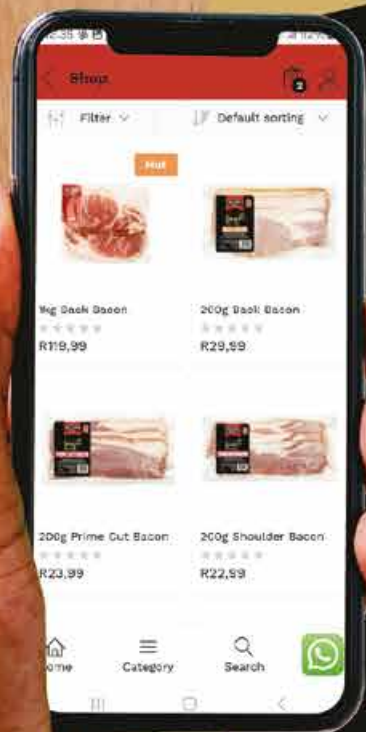


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GLENWOOD HIGH SCHOOL

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PETERHOUSE BOYS' SCHOOL

Kearsney College is delighted to host Peterhouse Boys' School's 1st XV squad and coaching staff for the first time, in a year they celebrate their 70th anniversary.

Peterhouse opened in 1955 outside the farming town of Marondera, on the main road between Harare and Mutare, under the rectorship of former Michaelhouse head Fred Snell. There were 55 boys, and within five years the number had risen to 360. In 2020, seventh rector and former headmaster of Kingswood College, Jon Trafford, was appointed to Peterhouse, where there are currently 600 boarders.

Known for its reputation of excellence both in the classroom and on the sports fields, the Peterhouse Group of Schools - comprising Peterhouse Boys, Peterhouse Girls and Springvale - has produced numerous international athletes.

Among the most notable sportsmen is Tendai 'Beast' Mtawarira, the Springbok's most capped prop who

earned 117 Test caps and won the 2019 Rugby World Cup with them. Other distinguished rugby players who have attended Peterhouse are Brian Mujati (Springboks), Scott Gray (Scotland), Brendon Mandivenga and Richard Tsimba (both Zimbabwe).

Peterhouse has made a mark at international level in cricket too. Stuart Carlisle, Ryan Burl and Brian Bennett have represented Zimbabwe, while Gary Ballance went on to play for England.

The school's proud sporting heritage also extends to the Olympics; with Micheen Thornycroft, Andrew Peebles and Stephen Cox having competed in rowing and Ken Harnden on the track for hurdles.

Away from the sports fields, other eminent alumni are retired Greenpeace chairman and environmental lawyer Martyn Day; British barrister and retired judge Peter Beaumont CBE QC; the Bank of England's former deputy governor and editor of The Economist, Rupert Pennant-Rea; Guy Scott, former vice-president of Zambia; as well as author and journalist Graham Boynton.

Several distinguished alumni have also contributed to the international arts and film industries, including Nyasha Hatendi, Rick Cosnett, Munyaradzi Chidzonga and Philip J Day.

Most of our boarders are weekly boarders, going home after their school commitments on a Saturday and returning on Sunday night or Monday morning before the start of school. The boys enjoy a good mix of quality family time and the fun and benefits of boarding.

Kearsney provides a Monday morning bus service to assist boarders returning to the College, with pickup points in Richards Bay, Mtunzini, Ballito and Umhlanga, as well as Hilton and Pietermaritzburg. Airport transfers are provided when the boys break up and return from holidays and half-term breaks.



Full boarding is provided for those boys who live further away or wish to be termly boarders. Termly boarders have access to the ample facilities on Sunday and enjoy a Sunday excursion.

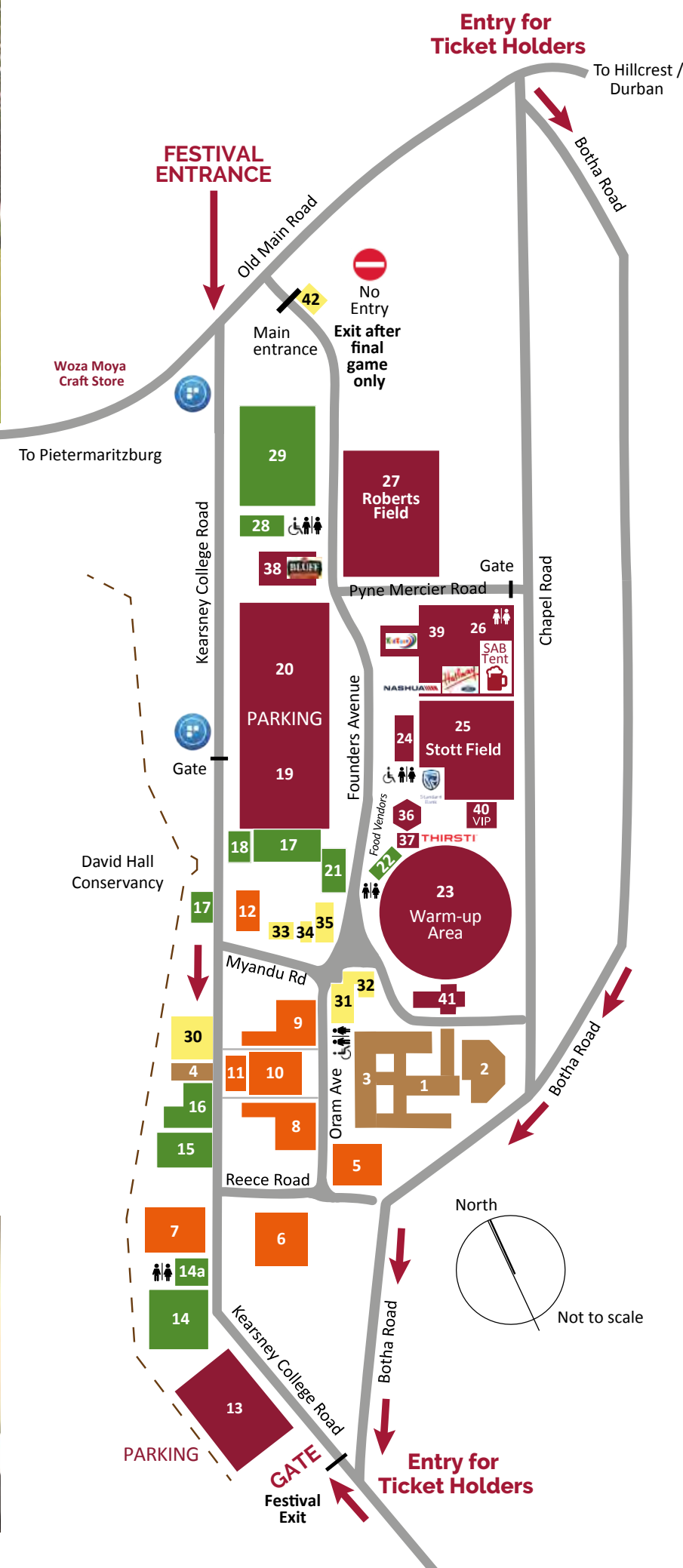
Boarding has many benefits for schoolboys, providing a structured and disciplined environment where the boys benefit academically, whilst enjoying the social and personal development benefits.
